Did you know?

- There are approximately 25000 people living with HIV in Australia and 1000 new infections per year.
- It is estimated that in NSW, 75% of chlamydia infections are not diagnosed.
- Large proportions of Australian men (55.0%) and women (60.5%) reported at least one sexual problem within the preceding year. More serious sexual dysfunction (> 3 symptoms) was observed in 13.2% of men and 19.7% of women¹.

ASHM NSW in partnership with the Nepean-Blue Mountains LHD has developed a new Active Learning Module covering bacterial and viral sexually transmitted infections (STIs), HIV Shared Care and Female/Male sexual dysfunction.

Focusing on learning needs as identified through discussions with GPs across NSW, this ALM will give general practitioners a broad overview of Sexual Health Medicine. The course aims to give skills and confidence to general practitioners so that they can identify those at risk for BBVs and STIs and overcome fears/embarrassment in taking sexual histories and examinations.

The course consists of three modules;

1. Overview of Bacterial and Viral Sexually Transmitted Infections
2. HIV Medicine and Shared Care
3. Female and Male Sexual Dysfunction
